PRE-INTERNATIONAL FOUNDATION YEAR (PRE-IFY)


A flexible programme of study for students who need to improve their English prior to entry to the International Foundation Year (IFY). Students join with IELTS 4.5 and are uplifted to IELTS 5.0.

NCUK's pre-university and undergraduate product portfolio provides a flexible and customisable delivery approach, enabling students to obtain a full bachelor's degree in a number of different ways



The above diagram shows the various ways in which a student can obtain a bachelor's degree by following NCUK programs at Mesarya Education House. Students have the choice to study NCUK programs at Mesarya Education House up to three years depending on their preference, with all students able to progress to the same outcome of obtaining a bachelor's degree from university.

As well as benefitting students by providing them with more ways to obtain a bachelor's degree, Mesarya Education House offers the full suite of pre-university and undergraduate qualifications.

Pre University & Undergraduate program also opens up opportunities for students looking for a more vocational direction rather than completing a full degree in one go.



1. International Foundation Year (IFY)

What is it?

Designed with our university partners exclusively for international students, the NCUK International Foundation Year combines a wide range of academic modules, study skills and English language training to provide a pathway to undergraduate degree courses at leading universities.

NARIC (National Academic
Recognition Information Centre)
formally recognises the NCUK
International Foundation Year as a
comparable level to GCE A Level,
Australian high school (SSCE), Hong
Kong Diploma of Secondary
Education (HKDSE), and American
high school (AP) qualifications

Who is it for?

Students who have completed high school (or a qualification that is GCSE equivalent) in their home country but require an additional qualification, and English language training to be prepared for overseas university study in English, for example in the UK, Australia, New Zealand, Canada or the USA.

How can it be delivered?

The IFY is designed to be taught over 9 months but can be adapted to be delivered over as little as 6 months. We have a number of different assessment periods to cater for different academic calendars.

Benefits to Students

- It is designed specifically for the needs of international students with multiple exit routes so students can keep their options open for longer
- A fast track route to university to get students where they want to be quicker
- English language preparation, and English language certification that students can use for visa purposes so there is no need for a separate IELTS test (or similar)
- Access to thousands of degree courses at leading universities worldwide so students have a wide variety of options to choose from and a one stop service that gets them there

1.1 International Foundation Year Progression

1.2 International Foundation Year: Medicine Pathway

What is it?

The IFY Medicine pathway has been designed in conjunction with St. George's University of Grenada (SGU). The pathway comprises of the typical science modules (Biology, Chemistry, Maths Science & EAP) plus a half-module in Anatomy & Physiology. This additional module gives students an introduction to the anatomy and physiology of the systems of the human body and helps prepare students for the type of content that will be covered in the early stages of a medical degree.

Who is it for?

The IFY Medicine pathway is designed for students who are aspirant to study medicine or a medical-related degree at university.



1.3 International Foundation Year: Art & Design

What is it?

Art The & Design module can be offered as a single or double module on the IFY alongside either one or other subject two modules. The module gives students the chance to experience and use different artistic mediums and develop their design skills. The module allows students to develop a portfolio of work, part of which can also be used for the student's application to arts-related university courses.

Who is it for?

The module is designed for students looking at progression to art and design related university courses

- Develop an exciting and extensive range of creative and technical skills



2. International Year One

What is it?

The International Year One (IYOne) is a university creditbearing qualification that enables students to study the first year of an undergraduate degree at an NCUK Study Centre and upon successful completion gives guaranteed access to the second year of a wide range of degree courses at NCUK Universities.

Mesarya Education House currently offers IYOne streams in

- Business Management
- Accounting & Finance
- Events Management
- Law
- Electrical & Electronic Engineering
- Mechanical & Manufacturing Engineering

Did you know?

Students can study the International Foundation Year and then progress to a Delivery Partner in another country to study the International Year One and experience a truly global degree.

Who is it for?

Students who have completed the International Foundation Year, or an equivalent qualification, and want to progress to study a bachelor's degree in the UK or Australia.

2.1 International Year One in Law (New Program)

What is it?

The International Year One in Law is the equivalent of the first year of a UK LLB Law degree. The programme covers the core areas of Contract Law, Criminal Law, Public Law and the English Legal System. Students will study the key areas of these modules whilst developing their legal research skills by investigating relevant case law using an online law library.



Who is it for?

The IYOne Law is suitable for students who are looking to take the first step to a career in law either in the UK or their home country. UK law degrees are well respected worldwide and can be useful for students entering a range of careers.

3. International Year Two (IYTwo) Business Management

What is it?

The International Year Two (IYTwo) Business Management is a credit-bearing qualification enables students to study the second year of an undergraduate at Mesarya Education degree starting House 2021 2022 academic year and upon successful completion gives guaranteed access to the final year of degree courses at NCUK Universities. The study of the IYTwo following the IYOne means that students can complete two of the three undergraduate years in their home country.

Who is it for?

The IYTwo is designed specifically for international students who have successfully completed the IYOne and want to complete a further year in their home country prior to completing their degree overseas.

Benefits for Students:

- Cost saving by studying in-country and paying lower tuition fees than at university for two years
- Cost saving on accommodation and living costs for two years
- Multiple exit routes

Progression routes:

Students will be able to progress onto the following degrees at a number of NCUK Universities:

- BA (Hons) Business Management
- BA (Hons) International Business Management
- BA (Hons) International Business
- BA (Hons) Business Studies







4. Master's Preparation

What is it?

NCUK's Master's Preparation gives students exposure to the skills required to succeed at master's degree level in the UK. Students will complete modules in English for Academic Purposes and Research Methods in order to develop their higher-level English and study skills.

The programme can be offered full time over 30, 20 or 10 weeks or can be adapted to be taught parttime over a longer period of time

Who is it for?

Designed specifically for students who have completed a degree in a language other than English, students can enter from degree courses from a number of different countries as well as from 3-year Diplomas from Chinese universities

Benefits to Students:

- Students will develop master's level skills in research and academic English
- English language preparation, and English language certification that students can use for visa purposes (no need for a separate IELTS)
- Students complete a mini dissertation, helping them to prepare for the dissertation they will complete on their master's programme
- NCUK's University Admissions Placement Team support the student in making a single application to multiple universities

5. Postgraduate Certificate (PGCert)

What is it?

NCUK is currently looking into ways in which we can further support students who aspire to complete a master's degree in the UK. One possible solution for this is the development of а Postgraduate Certificate that would allow students to complete 60 credits of master's study with an NCUK Delivery Partner, prior to completing the additional 120 credits overseas.

To begin with, the subject area is likely to be Business Management, but this could be extended to other disciplines in future.

Benefits to Students:

- Cost saving by completing one third of a master's degree in their home country
- Delivery of EAP and RM at the delivery partner with dedicated support in small classes
- Experience of studying some modules online which will assist with the transition to their master's programme and further study

According to the recently published Universities UK international graduate outcomes survey, careers employability rank highly amongst factors influencing graduate study choice. NCUK agrees and sees further potential to work with our partners to ensure students are well prepared for their future at university and beyond. Many international students develop careers in their home country and working together to forge industry support will help student opportunity. Recent UK changes to post-study work visas from 2020/21 provide an excellent opportunity for international find students to employment in the UK after their study and this welcome initiative also drives the need to prepare our students to make the most of it. This also applies in Australia and New Zealand where students are able to apply for a visa to work for up to three years after completion of their degree, depending on their region of study.

international The survey suggests students make insufficient use of the excellent career services offered by universities and are less confident and familiar with the language the innovative employability and teaching methods that support it. As such NCUK has a role to play in preparing students to navigate university life where employability will be at the heart of their study and beyond. To support this, employability will form an integral part of our longterm Teaching & Learning Strategy and development. future product partners in this journey we invite you at this year's conference to explore how we can achieve this together. In the short-term we will be adding additional resources to our Master's Preparation to assist students with key areas that will assist employability such as CV writing. We will also be updating our website pages help students to the array of initiatives navigate available within our universities.

8. The NCUK English Language Test

NCUK has been developing and testing an online test of English. Many of our universities have logistical issues with overseas students being able to take an IELTS test or similar in their home country prior to applying for a visa. In order to provide a solution for this problem, NCUK is developing a test to be accepted for entry by our university partners.

The NCUK English Language Test will give Mesarya Education House the chance to become an official NCUK Approved Test Centre, offering tests to university referred students seeking proof of English testing in order to get their visa for their place at university. The NCUK Test Centre model would also allow you to provide English language testing to other students (A-level/IB etc) as a speedier alternative to other English language test suppliers.

In the longer term NCUK will be developing study programmes for NCUK English Language Test that will enable Delivery Partners to deliver short preparatory courses as well as the final test.
