## INTERNATIONAL YEAR ONE (IYONE)

The International Year One (IYOne) is a credit-bearing qualification that enables you to study the first year of an undergraduate degree at Mesarya Education House and upon successful completion, enter the second year of a wide range of degree courses at NCUK Universities. Students benefit from smaller classes, allowing thorough academic preparation and support to ensure a smooth transition into university study.

## NCUK PRE MASTER

This programme benefits from wide recognition across the UK. It also offers international students, who do not qualify for direct entry to university, a pathway into postgraduate studies at a British university.

## ENGLISH LANGUAGE COURSES

This course is designed to improve general English language proficiency for use in academics. Our courses are suitable for students of all levels from Elementary to Advanced.

To enter undergraduate or postgraduate degree courses in the UK, international students must satisfy English language requirements. The most successful students are those who take the time to improve their level of English language beyond standard entry requirements. ## INTERNATIONAL FOUNDATION PROGRAM

Lasting one academic year (two terms), the programme is the perfect preparation for international students planning undergraduate study in the UK or Europe. The qualification also enables students to prepare for study at a wide range of other UK universities. The programme combines academic study, intensive English language preparation, study skills and cultural orientation.

## WHY CHOOSE THE INTERNATIONAL FOUNDATION PROGRAMME?

The International Foundation programme gives students a level of academic preparation comparable to UK high school graduates and ensures that students meet the English language entry requirements for university study.

## WHAT IS SPECIAL ABOUT THE INTERNATIONAL FOUNDATION PROGRAMME?

This is an academically challenging programme, designed by NCUK for students who want direct entry to the first year of an undergraduate course at one of the partner universities or other UK institutions. It is designed for international students who have completed 12 years of schooling and achieved high grades in the subjects they wish to study. Successful completion of the International Foundation programme, therefore, leads to an award welcomed by the other top-ranking UK institutions.



## KEY FEATURES



### PROGRAMME STRUCTURE

The September start programme is taught over two semesters. The final week of each term is used for review and exams. Exceptionally qualified students who begin in January will complete the programme in two terms: the Universities may require slightly higher pass grades from these students.

### ACADEMIC CONTENT

Around two-thirds of the programme is devoted to academic modules from students' own subject areas, supported by tuition in English language and Study Skills, and Academic English and Study Skills. January start 'fast-track' students undertake all academic modules but with a reduced English language component.

### ACADEMIC ENGLISH LANGUAGE SUPPORT

At the core of the programme, the module in Academic English takes up approximately a third of the time. Study in English covers reading, writing, listening and speaking. The English language component is the NCUK English for Academic Purposes (EAP) module and is assessed using NCUK's widely recognised EAP assessment system.

## RECOMMENDED STUDY PLAN AND PROGRESSION ROUTES

Students who meet the programme's academic entry requirements but who have an IELTS score of less than 5.0 can undertake English language preparation before entering the two term Foundation programme.

## A TYPICAL INTERNATIONAL FOUNDATION PROGRAMME WEEK

A typical week will have up to 24 hours of timetabled lessons, including lectures, directed self-study and enquiry-based group work. Lessons may take the form of classes, workshops, tutorials or, in science courses, practical laboratory sessions and field trips. Students have plenty of opportunity to discuss informally with their tutors any points raised in lectures and seminars. In the laboratory, students will carry out experiments relating to their lectures. These sessions are supervised by tutors and demonstrators who will ensure the safe execution of the experiments and discuss the theory behind them.

Students are able to work in the well-equipped learning centre at Mesarya Education House, and use the large network of computer terminals for research, including on-line access to libraries and the web.

### SUBJECT PATHWAYS

All international students attending a pre university course are assured progression to year one of a UK degree course subject to meeting specified grades based on

- satisfactory completion of course work
- performance criteria in examinations
- an appropriate IELTS/TOEFL level determined by performance on the EAP examination.

Students meeting the performance criteria are guaranteed places among one of the partner universities.



## ASSESSMENT AND SUPPORT

Progress is checked by continuous assessment of course work and by the use of class tests. The final grade for each unit is based on a mixture of course work and end-of-course examinations. Successful students will achieve grades A, B, C or D for each of the four units. Basic information will be delivered in lectures, while the students' understanding of the subject and their ability to utilize the information will be supported by tutorial work and by extensive e-learning provision.

Assessment will be by:

- \* coursework (prepared assignments, unit tests, experimental reports, computer use
- \* mid-course and end-of-course examinations

Formal assessment of levels and progress in English will be undertaken using the assessment protocols from the NCUK's English for Academic Purposes (EAP) programme.

PLEASE NOTE: The pass mark for academic modules is grade D. although the NCUK certificate will be awarded to students achieving pass grades, all programmes at the University of Manchester will set entry criteria substantially above that level, requiring high grades in academic modules and a minimum of grade B in the EAP programme assessments. for a number of programmes this will be even higher – demanding grade A or A\* in some cases.

# INTERNATIONAL YEAR ONE (IYONE)

After completing the IFY (or equivalent qualification) students have the option to study the International Year One: a credit bearing qualification that enables you to study the first year of a UK Bachelor's Degree then progress to university and enter the second year of an undergraduate degree at an NCUK University.

It varies depending on your subject area. The majority of modules are assessed by a combination of coursework and examination, with the exam accounting for at least 75% of the final mark. A small number of modules are assessed entirely by coursework. All assessments are set and moderated by NCUK.

## WHAT HAPPENS IF I DON'T GET THE RESULTS I WAS EXPECTING?

We know that not all students achieve their predicted grades. Because of our unique relationship with the NCUK Universities, we are able to offer a Clearing Service. If you don't get into your first choice University, we can still find you a suitable alternative. You receive a set of guaranteed offers at the same time that you get your results. All you have to do is choose the one that's right for you.



The pass mark for academic modules is grade D. although the NCUK certificate will be awarded to students achieving pass grades, all programmes at the University of Manchester will set entry criteria substantially above that level, requiring high grades in academic modules and a minimum of grade B in the EAP programme assessments. for a number of programmes this will be even higher – demanding grade A or A\* in some cases.

# PRE MASTER'S PROGRAM

## WHY DO STUDENTS CHOOSE TO FOLLOW THE PRE-MASTER'S PROGRAMME?



Studying a Master's degree at a British university can be a stressful experience for students who are new to the UK. The different study methods, language, culture, friends and new accommodation can place a lot of pressure on students in their first few months. This programme provides the skills and study methods that students need to integrate fully into the academic environment and into their chosen Master's course.

International students from different disciplines can also use the nine months NCUK Pre-Master's Programme as a conversion course allowing entrance into UK postgraduate study in the areas of BUSINESS and MANAGEMENT in addition to those relating to their first degree or diploma study. International students with a degree in Business or Economics and with sufficient language ability can use the six months or three months NCUK PMP as a fast track to UK postgraduate study, subject to IELTS grades on entry.

## IS THE PRE-MASTER'S PROGRAMME VALIDATED OR RECOGNISED?

The Pre-Master's Programme is designed by the Northern Consortium of UK Universities (NCUK) and is accepted by universities across the country for direct entry to taught Master's programmes. Successful completion of the PMP leads to the award of the NCUK certificate, issued on behalf of the NCUK owner universities. The course is, therefore, a first step towards obtaining a postgraduate qualification

## ASSURED UNIVERSITY PLACEMENT

All students who successfully pass the NCUK Pre-Master's Programme offered by MEH are guaranteed a place on a taught Master's or MBA degree at one of the NCUK partner universities.

Note: Students who progress on to an NCUK partner university receive a £500 bursary towards their university tuition fees.

Mesarya Education House offers the world-renowned NCUK Pre-Master's Programme, all students who successfully pass this programme are guaranteed a place on a taught Master's or MBA degree at one of the NCUK partner universities.

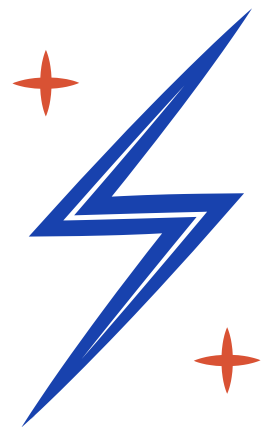


## WHAT IS THE NCUK PRE-MASTER'S PROGRAMME

This programme is designed to develop the study methods and academic English language skills of international students who are preparing for Master's degree study in the UK. Students who pass this course are guaranteed a place on a taught Master's degree at one of the NCUK member universities. In addition, passing the PreMaster's will increase the students' chances of successfully finishing their Master's degree. Students who have successfully completed a 3 year university diploma can use this course as a conversion programme.

This means that their diploma can be recognised by many universities as a qualifying programme, therefore increasing the range of Master's courses available to them. Many Master's degrees such as Science, Engineering, Finance or Accounting require students to have a degree or diploma in a related field.

However, students wanting to study Business or Management but did not study in this area previously, can use the Pre-Master's as a way of adapting their skills for entry onto these Master's degrees.



# ENGLISH FOR ACADEMIC PURPOSE



## STUDY SKILLS

An essential preparation for university life, this part of the course helps students to work in groups, present ideas, manage their time, conduct research, make lecture notes, organise the content of essays and understand how to evaluate their own work. Students on Business or Humanities pathways must learn how to research, prepare and write extended essays. Students will develop confidence, knowledge and skills in the following key areas: organising and presenting information. These skills are included in the English for Academic Purposes module but are also embedded into all other modules of the course.

The module introduces reading techniques for academic study, the structure and function of academic writing, writing English clearly and appropriately using an adequate range of sentence structures and vocabulary, and the ability to take part in academic discussion.

Students will also learn techniques for listening to lectures, taking notes, making oral presentations, summarizing, paraphrasing, using dictionaries effectively, writing clearly and concisely under timed conditions and understanding graphs and diagrams. In particular, students will be introduced to a variety of academic writing modes (e.g. narrative, descriptive, argumentative) and how to present academic writing according to the correct conventions.

In the latter part of the course, students learn how to plan, write and review academic assignments; use citation and referencing appropriately; use a range of appropriate reading strategies when faced with challenging text; organise ideas and arguments in a clear and logical manner; revise, edit and proof-read written work; participate successfully in seminars and discussions about academic topics (including the use of turn-taking, asking questions, agreeing and disagreeing); oral presentations.



# STUDENT SERVICES: SUPPORTING YOU FROM THE DAY YOU ARRIVE

## PRIOR TO ENROLMENT



Your first point of contact with MEH is likely to be with one of MEH's representatives in your home country. Our network of education advisers and agents recognise the importance of the choices you are making and are well informed about our programmes and the universities. They will happily answer any questions you may have and assist you with your application.

## ARRIVAL



Students must arrange to arrive in Nicosia at the beginning of Orientation Week or on the weekend before the first day of their course. You must inform MEH International Office of your travel arrangements at least two weeks in advance of your arrival date so we can inform the immigration office about your arrival for your visa-free travel arrangements.

## 24-HOUR SUPPORT



MEH is dedicated to ensuring that you feel totally safe and supported. Upon arrival all Mesarya Education House students are issued with an emergency telephone number that can be used to ask for assistance from MEH staff at any time of the day or night.



## **ORIENTATION PROGRAM**

On arrival, a comprehensive orientation programme is provided to welcome you as a new student and introduce you to studying at the MEH. The orientation programme includes a formal academic induction where you will be registered for your programme, take an English language placement test (if required), receive your timetable and, for academic programmes, select your modules. You will also be given a tour of the available facilities and introduction to the city centre so that you can learn about the local transport systems and where to find the best places to shop. During orientation there are also daily organized social activities to help you settle into life at the Study House and meet other students

## **STUDENT SERVICES TEAM**

The MEH Student Services team will be your first point of contact and will help you with any non-academic issues ranging from registering with the immigration and health insurance through to setting up a bank account, leaving you free to focus on your studies. The Student Services team are also responsible for the orientation programme and the on-going social programme. Personal tutors will guide you in the development of a study plan that will help you to manage your studies and progress.

## **LANGUAGE ADVISERS**

Student Services team are available to assist new and prospective students and parents in terms of unofficial translation needs, who may not be able to communicate effectively in Turkish.

## **SOCIAL ACTIVITIES**

MEH organizes various social activities for the students in cooperation with the Student Council. The mission is to make sure that students spending their extra curricular time effectively.
